General waste

This is general waste:

WASTE MUST BE DISPOSED OF IN A CLOSED PLASTIC BAG

- › Diapers and sanitary napkins
- › Books, hardback
- › CDs/DVDs/VHS cassettes
- › Giftwrap
- › Glass and plastics, other than food containers/packaging
- › Rubber and leather
- › Pet faeces, cat and bird litter (small amounts, well wrapped!)
- › Ovenproof dishes
- › Cold ash (well wrapped!)
- › Crystal
- › Cosmetics
- › Food
- › Greaseproof paper
- › Plastic toys, Lego etc.
- › Porcelain
- › Mirrors
- › Needles/syringes (well wrapped!)
- › Vacuum cleaner bags
- › Soup packets
- › Soiled paper/cardboard
- › Soiled plastic packaging
- › Paper towels/napkins
- › Worn-out clothes/shoes
- › Broken windows (well wrapped)
- › Polystyrene (large amounts can be brought to Heggstadmoen gjenvinningsstasjon)

NOTE: All waste must be bagged



Paper and cardboard

This is paper:

MUST BE DISPOSED OF AS LOOSE ITEMS

- › Newspapers
- › Paperback books
- › Milk cartons (rinse and fold, pack several into one carton)
- › Egg cartons
- › Juice and dessert cartons
- › Envelopes
- › Food packaging (pizza boxes etc.)
- › Advertising flyers etc.
- › Writing paper
- › Magazines
- › Washing powder boxes

This is cardboard:

- › Corrugated cardboard
- › Cardboard boxes (tear in pieces or fold flat)

NOTE: Dispose of large quantities of cardboard at a "returpunkt" or gjenvinningsstasjon



Plastic packaging

This is plastic packaging:

MUST BE DISPOSED OF IN A CLOSED PLASTIC BAG

- › Potato chip bag
- › Food trays (for meat, poultry etc.)
- › Ice cream boxes
- › Coffee bags (plastic)
- › Plastic cups (for sour cream, yoghurt etc.)
- › Plastic bottles and corks (non-refundable)
- › Plastic wrapping (e.g. packaging for new furniture)
- › Plastic flower pots
- › Plastic bags
- › Plastic pails (e.g. "sodd" soup pails)
- › Chocolate wrapping



Hazardous waste

This is hazardous waste:

- › Batteries
- › Bleach, chloride, ammonia
- › Car and boat-care
- › Packaging for hazardous waste
- › Light bulbs and energy saving light bulbs (whole)
- › Used rags/cloths with solvents (put in a closed container with water.)
- › Light tubes (Put beside box in original packaging)
- › Mercury thermometers
- › Paint, laquer, stain, glue
- › Paint and laquer remover
- › Plant treatment chemicals
- › Small electric appliances (Smoke detectors, mobile phones, hairdryes)
- › Spray cans
- › Oil and tar waste
- › White spirit, methylated spirits
- › Electric/battery powered toys
- › Ammunition og explosives must be handed over to the police
- › Old/unused medicine must be returned to a chemist/pharmacy
- › Needles and syringes are disposed of as general waste (well wrapped)



Glass/metal

This is glass and metal packaging

Items disposed of as general waste

- › Aluminium trays
- › Baby food jars
- › Tin/aluminium cans
- › Jam/food jars
- › Non-refundable bottles

Glass and metal waste must be brought to a "returpunkt" Check www.trv.no for your nearest "returpunkt"

- › Ovenproof dishes
- › Crystal
- › Porcelain
- › Mirrors
- › Windows (well wrapped)
